## Summer Camps

July 22–26, 2019

### 1 Splash, Swish, Swirl!: An Art Exploration

(Grades 1–2) Explore the elements of art through a variety of multimedia projects inspired by works on view at the Museum. From the Art of the 20th Century galleries to outdoor sculpture, learn about master artists and play art games.

### 2 Build It, Shape It, Sculpt It!: Exploring 3-D Art

(Grades 3–5) Create sculptural works of art with materials such as clay, wood, wire, and recyclable materials while exploring volume and scale in works on view at the Museum, including the May S. Marcy Sculpture Garden and the Art of the Open Air installation.

### 3 Let's Go Wild: Animals in Art

(Grades 1–2) Find animals in art both in the Museum galleries and around Balboa Park and create paintings and sculptures inspired by what you see and sketch. Collaborate with classmates on a beast-inspired mural.

### 4 All Mixed Up!: Exploring Materials in Art

(Grades 3–5) Learn to layer art materials to create mixed media projects combining painting, drawing, printmaking and more. Explore a variety of materials ranging from fine art supplies to recycled materials in the classroom and learn about multimedia artists in the galleries.

## Teen Summer Studios

August 5–9, 2019

### A Expanding Your Portfolio

(Grades 9–12) Take your artwork in new directions by meeting with other teen artists and creating a portfolio for submission to fine arts colleges. View masterworks from around the world in the Museum and discover new art forms while receiving expert guidance on how to develop and expand your portfolio.

### B Making Multiples: Exploring Printmaking

(Grades 6–8) Discover ways to produce art in multiples by exploring a variety of printmaking techniques. Explore the galleries while learning about master printmakers. Design and print your own personal t-shirt.

August 12–16, 2019

### C Travel through the Museum: Spain and Beyond

(Grades 9–12) Travel back in time to discover works of art from all over Europe. Visit *Art and Empire: The Golden Age of Spain* and the European galleries and learn about innovative techniques used by the old masters, from Velázquez to Zurbarán while creating your own masterpieces of painting, sculpture, decorative arts, and more.

### D Beyond the Paintbrush: Painting Techniques and More

(Grades 6–8) Explore traditional and contemporary painting techniques through a variety of art processes, from realistic landscapes to abstract portraits. Explore the Museum galleries while sketching masterworks and get your creativity flowing plein-air painting in the Park.
