Think timeless architecture, luminous galleries, and the effortless elegance of celebrating amid world-class art, all tailored for gatherings that feel deeply personal.

From minimalist modern to classic romantic, the Mini Masterpiece captures the essence of what makes a wedding unforgettable: connection, beauty, and the joy of the moment.

- *Up to 20 guests*
- *Up to 2 hour ceremony*
- *Two white, black, or acrylic clear pedestals*
- *Two floral arrangements designed for pedestal display*
- *One seasonal bridal bouquet*
- *One seasonal boutonniere*
- *Setup and breakdown coordinated with the Museum's event timeline*

All days except Wednesday, Event Start 6:00 p.m.-8:00 p.m.

# Classic Luxe

A refined, art-forward ceremony arrangement designed to complement the Museum's architecture and surroundings.

- *Ceremony chairs: Chiavari chairs in black, white, natural, or fruitwood, with black or ivory chair pads*
- *Style notes: Clean, elegant, and intentionally neutral, allowing the Museum environment to remain the focal point.*



# Modern Elegance

A contemporary ceremony arrangement defined by clean lines, modern materials, and a streamlined, architectural feel.

- *Ceremony chairs: Ghost in clear or smoke; Brentwood in black or white*
- *Style notes: Minimal and modern, with an emphasis on form, material, and contrast. Floral design remains consistent with the Classic Luxe package, allowing the furnishings to define the overall look.*



# Timeless Heritage

A refined ceremony arrangement with traditional silhouettes and warm materials, offering a timeless look that feels elegant and considered.

- *Ceremony chairs: Vineyard in natural or distressed white; Wishbone in natural or white*
- *Style notes: Classic in form and proportion, with subtle detailing that adds warmth and character. The overall look remains understated and cohesive, allowing the Museum environment to remain the focal point.*

### **\$1,750 – Tier 2**

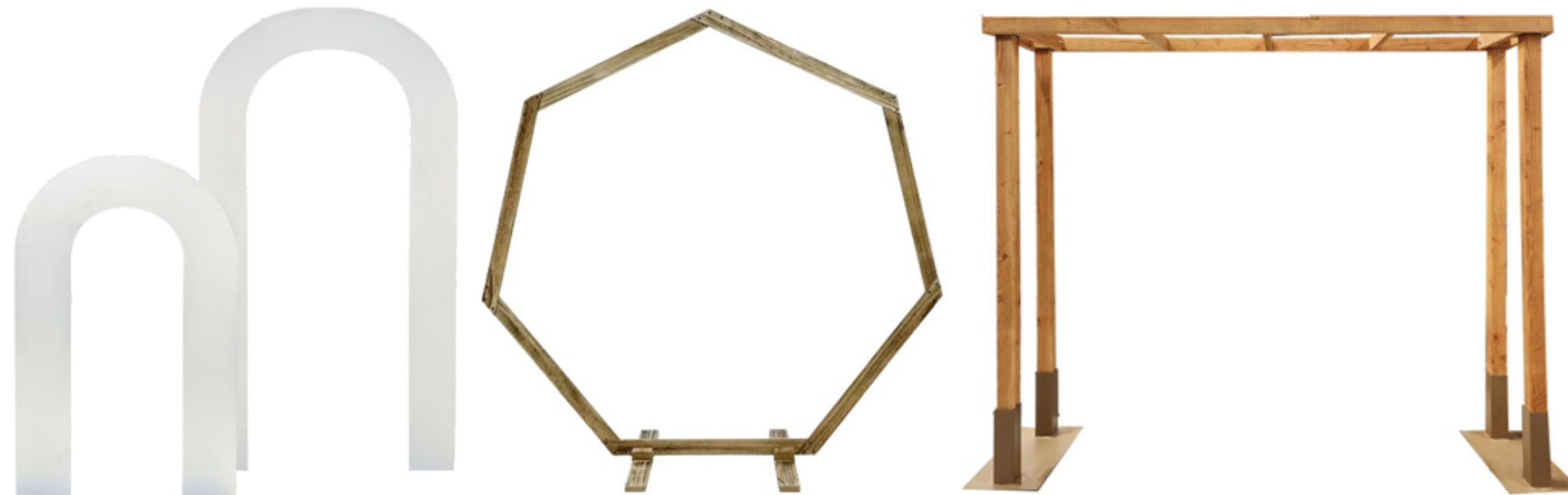

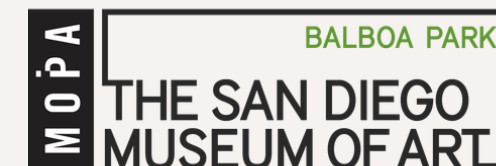
